

Continuing Education Provider Status, by State

Please note: This information was compiled as a convenience for our workshop participants who might wish to obtain credit for the hours of instruction spent in completing a Lindamood-Bell® workshop.

We recommend that you use this credit information as a guide only, and that, prior to taking a workshop, you verify the information to ensure its accuracy with your school, school district, state board, or other licensing or accrediting agency. You are responsible for verifying acceptance of any CEUs offered for a Lindamood-Bell® workshop with your particular agency.

Alabama:

The Teacher Education and Certification Office of the Alabama Department of Education will accept Lindamood-Bell® CEUs towards the renewal of professional certificates. Contact Alabama Department of Education Teacher Certification for more information. *DOE (334) 242-9977*

Alaska:

Educators who attend workshops offered by Lindamood-Bell® and receive a letter of completion may submit the letter of completion (or a photocopy of the letter of completion) to the Office of Teacher Recruitment and Retention in the Alaska Department of Education and Early Development to receive non-academic credit toward certificate renewal. Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if credit earned will count toward salary placement credit.

*Note: Fifteen contact hours are equal to one non-academic credit, which replaces one lower division university semester credit for certificate renewal purposes. *DOE (907) 465-8663*

Arizona:

Educators may submit letters of completion from Lindamood-Bell® workshops to their school or school district for verification in order to use Lindamood-Bell® workshops towards their required Professional Development Activities.

Arkansas:

Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if credit earned at a Lindamood-Bell® workshop will be counted toward their professional development requirements.

California:

Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if credit earned at a Lindamood-Bell® workshop can be used toward their teaching credential.

Colorado:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop may submit their letter of completion (or a photocopy of their letter of completion) to the Educator Licensing Unit of the

Colorado Department of Education to use toward the renewal of a Professional License.

Connecticut:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop should contact the Connecticut State Department of Education Continuing Education Unit to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used towards recertification or professional development requirements. *DOE (860) 713-6969*

Delaware:

Educators who receive Lindamood-Bell® CEUs for attending a Lindamood-Bell® workshop may submit their original Completion Letter toward their required 90 clock hours for Educators' license renewal. Contact the Delaware Department of Education for more information. *DOE (302) 735-4120*

District of Columbia:

The District of Columbia does not accept Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs for license renewal, so educators must contact their Local Education Agency to find out if Lindamood-Bell® workshop hours can be counted toward renewal requirements. *SEA (202) 442-5377*

Florida:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and want credit must contact their individual school district regarding renewal.

Georgia:

As of September 1, 2006, educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and receive Lindamood-Bell® CEUs may submit their CEUs to the Georgia Department of Education to be used towards their teacher certification renewal. *DOE (404) 657-2951 GPSC (404) 232-2500*

Hawaii:

Once license renewal is mandatory (after License Renewal Pilot Program) educators will be able to submit Lindamood-Bell® CEUs toward their 60 points needed for license renewal. For more information, contact HTSB License Renewal *(808) 586-2605*

Idaho:

Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs cannot count directly toward certification, however educators can get one renewal credit if their individual school district signs off on an Idaho Inservice Form B7 (located on DOE website), verifying that the educator completed 15 clock hours of acceptable training. Up to three of the six renewal credits may be earned by that option. *DOE (208) 322-6901*

Illinois:

Lindamood-Bell® is an Approved Provider of professional development for the Illinois State Board of Education. **Our provider number is 04082010125352. Expires 12/30/2011.**

*Note: Continuing Professional Development Units (CPDUs) can be earned one per contact hour. Continuing Education Units (CEUs) are for teaching certificate renewal only;

one CEU (five clock hours) is equivalent to five CDPUs. One semester hour is equivalent to 15 CDPUs.

Indiana:

Educators should contact the Indian Department of Education to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used towards the Indiana Teaching Certificate Renewal Process or for the eligibility requirements for initial certificate holders. *DOE (317) 232-9010 or (866) 542-3672 or email dpshelpdesk@doe.in.gov.*

Iowa:

Iowa does not recognize Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs for license renewal. *DOE (515) 281-6131 BOEE (515) 281-3245*

Kansas:

Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if credit earned at a Lindamood-Bell® workshop can be counted towards professional development or teacher certification renewal. *DOE (785) 296-8010*

Kentucky:

Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if credit earned at a Lindamood-Bell® workshop can be counted towards professional development or teacher certification renewal. *DOE (502) 564-4201*

Louisiana:

Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if credit earned at a Lindamood-Bell® workshop can be used as Continuing Learning Units (CLUs). *DOE (877) 453-2721*

Maine:

Educators who take a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and wish to receive credit towards recertification must receive permission from their local certification support system before attending the workshop. *CERTIFICATION OFFICE (207) 624-6603*

Maryland:

Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if credit earned at a Lindamood-Bell® workshop can be counted towards professional development or teacher certification renewal. *DOE (410) 767-0391*

Massachusetts:

Educators should contact the Massachusetts Department of Education to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used towards professional development requirements. *DOE (781) 338-6767*

Michigan:

Educators who attend Lindamood-Bell® workshops and choose to receive Lindamood-Bell® CEUs must submit their letter of completion within 30 days of the end of the workshop to their SB-CEU Coordinator in order to receive credit. The SB-Coordinator will then convert the Lindamood-Bell® CEUs (accredited by IACET) into SB-CEUs. *DOE (517) 241-4546*

Minnesota:

Educators who wish to use credit earned by attending a Lindamood-Bell® workshop towards their required clock hours must check with their local continuing education committee for approval.

Mississippi:

Educators should contact the Mississippi Department of Education to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used towards relicensure. *DOE (601) 432-6518*

Missouri:

Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if hours at a Lindamood-Bell® workshop can be counted as professional development contact hours toward teacher certification renewal. *DOE (573) 751-0051*

Montana:

Educators should contact the Montana Office of Public Instruction to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used towards renewal unit credit. *DOE (406) 444-5726*

Nebraska:

Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if credit earned at a Lindamood-Bell® workshop can be counted towards renewal of a teaching certificate or step increase. *DOE (402) 471-4304*

Nevada:

Educators should contact the Nevada Department of Education to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used towards renewal credit. *DOE (702) 486-6458*

New Hampshire:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and are in a New Hampshire school district must have the workshop approved by their district prior to attendance to use as part of their Individual Professional Development Plan. Educators who are not in a school district and wish to receive credit would need to submit their letter of completion to the New Hampshire Department of Education Bureau of Credentialing for approval. New Jersey:

Lindamood-Bell® is a recognized Professional Development Provider for the New Jersey Department of Education. There is no expiration date at this time.

New Mexico:

Educators should contact the New Mexico Public Education Department to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used towards endorsements. Educators must contact their individual school district to find out if credit earned at a Lindamood-Bell® workshop can be counted towards a step increase. *PED (505) 827-5821*

New York:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and want to use the credits they earn towards their required 75 hours of professional development must contact their individual school district for approval. *DOE (518) 474-3901*

North Carolina:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and wish to use the credit they earn toward their required 10 semester hours or 15 units of renewal credit must contact their employer for approval.

North Dakota:

Educators who wish to use credit earned by attending a Lindamood-Bell® workshop towards their professional development must contact their individual district for approval. *DOE (888) 605-1951*

Ohio:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and wish to receive credit towards their Educator License Renewal must first take their letter of completion to their employing school, district, or agency before submitting credits earned to the Ohio Department of Education. *DOE (877) 644-6338*

Oklahoma:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and wish to receive credit towards their required 75 hours of professional development must contact their local district for approval. *DOE (405) 521-3301*

Oregon:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and wish to receive PDUs (Professional Development Units) for Educator License renewal must contact their individual school districts for approval.

*Note: A PDU equates to one clock hour.

Pennsylvania:

Educators should contact the Pennsylvania Department of Education to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used towards on-task hours. *DOE (717) 783-4307*

Rhode Island:

Educators who plan to attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and wish to receive credit hours must apply in advance to the Rhode Island Department of Education for approval. *DOE (401) 222-4600*

South Carolina:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and choose to receive Lindamood-Bell® CEUs (accredited by IACET) and who want to receive credit towards the renewal of their teacher certification must check with their individual school district to see if they have a pre-approval policy. If the workshop is approved, then the educator may submit their letter of completion to his or her District Renewal Plan Coordinator or designee.

*Note: The workshop must support the Professional Growth and Development Plan of the educator in order for it to be considered. *DOE (803) 734-4065*

South Dakota:

Educators should contact the South Dakota Department of Education to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used toward certificate renewal credit. *DOE (605) 773-4774*

Tennessee:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and receive Lindamood-Bell® CEUs (accredited through IACET) may submit earned credit on official documentation with their Professional License Renewal Application to the Tennessee Department of Education to be counted towards the required 90 points for license renewal.

*Note: 1 CEU equals 10 points. *DOE (615) 532-4884*

Texas:

Lindamood-Bell® is an approved CPE (Continuing Professional Education) provider for the State of Texas. **Our provider identification number is: 500859.** No expiration date at this time.

Utah:

Educators who attend a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and want to receive license points may submit their letter of completion showing CEUs earned to the Utah Department of Education.

Vermont:

Educators who take a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and want to receive professional development credit toward relicensure must submit their letter of completion to their individual district for approval.

*Note: 15 clock hours of professional development is equal to 1 relicensure credit.

Virginia:

Educators who take a Lindamood-Bell® workshop and wish to receive credit toward licensure renewal must first submit their letter of completion to their individual district for approval. If approved, the educator may submit their letter of completion to the Virginia Department of Education Division of Teacher Education and Licensure to receive Professional Development Points toward their licensure renewal. *DOE (804) 371-2522*

*Note: Educators receive 1 point per clock hour/contact time towards their licensure renewal.

**Note: Educators must take more than one workshop in order to receive points because the professional development guidelines only count workshop series'.

Washington:

Lindamood-Bell® is not approved by the Washington State Board of Education to provide clock hours, as it is not a public or private school, government agency, or non-profit agency. Please contact the Washington Department of Education for more information. *DOE (360) 725-6396*

West Virginia:

Educators who wish to use credit earned by attending a Lindamood-Bell® workshop towards their salary increase and/or recertification must contact their individual district for approval.

Wisconsin:

CEUs are not recognized by the Wisconsin Department of Public Instruction for license renewal. *DOE (608) 266-3390*

Wyoming:

Educators should contact the Wyoming Department of Education to see if Lindamood-Bell® IACET approved CEUs can be used toward Professional Development requirements.
